The first Festival took place in 2005, together with the musicians of the renowned Berlin Philharmonic who make up the Scharoun Ensemble, named after the architect chosen by Herbert von Karajan to build the concert hall, which, 50 years after its inauguration, still remains one of the most beautiful ones in the world.

The Zermatt Festival is also a kind of rebirth of the rich musical life which was Zermatt's between 1951 and 1967. At that time, the fabulous cellist Pablo Casals came to Zermatt every summer to give a Masterclass to numerous young musicians, whilst also giving concerts with his colleagues, Yehudi Menuhin, Clara Haskil or Mieczysław Horszowski for instance; he also liked to go for walks, play petanque or meet up for a drink of wine with his mountain guide friends.

True to tradition, the 2014 Festival will again welcome its residence ensemble, the musicians of the Scharoun Ensemble, who, after the summer concerts of the Berlin Philharmonic in Salzburg, Baden-Baden or Lucerne, come to Zermatt to recharge their batteries in a studious and friendly atmosphere, with about thirty students of the highest calibre, keen to share and absorb musical knowledge and experiences.

Come and meet them from 5th to 21th September 2014, in the beautiful, luminous churches of Zermatt and Riffelalp, where they will be playing Mozart, Schubert, Brahms or Dvorak.

In harmony with Zermatt, authentic village dominated by the majestic beauty of the Matterhorn, the Festival pursues its vocation to present musical excellence with passion and simplicity.

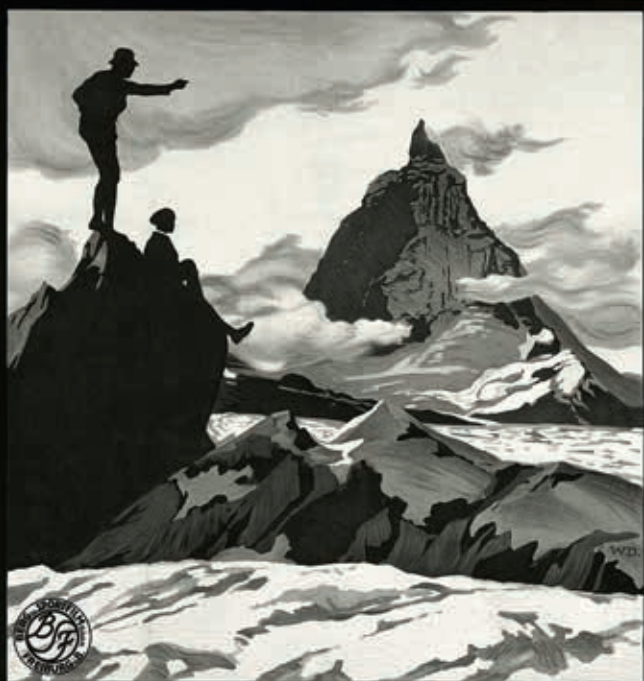

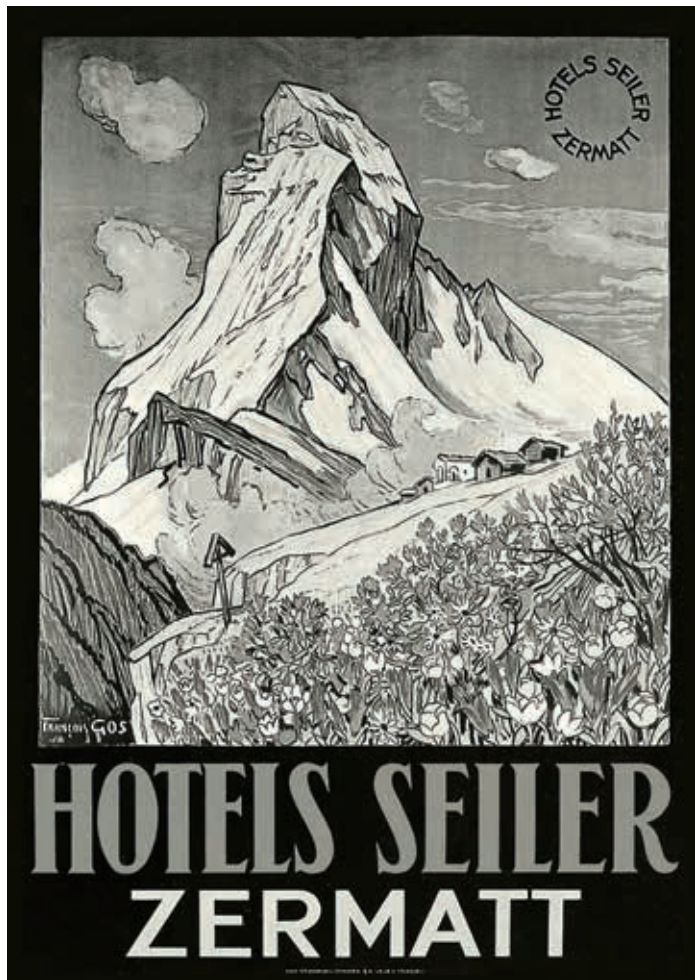

Founded in 1983 by members of the Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra, the Scharoun Ensemble is one of Germany's leading chamber-music organizations. With its wide repertoire, ranging from composers of the Baroque period by way of Classical and Romantic chamber music to contemporary works, the Scharoun Ensemble has been inspiring audiences in Europe and overseas for more than a quarter of a century. Innovative programming, a refined tonal culture and spirited interpretations are hallmarks of the ensemble, which performs in a variety of instrumental combinations.

The permanent core of the Scharoun Ensemble is a classical octet (clarinet, bassoon, horn, two violins, viola, cello and double bass), made up of members of the Berlin Philharmonic. The Scharoun Ensemble has prepared and presented various programmes under the direction of Claudio Abbado, Sir Simon Rattle, Daniel Barenboim and Pierre Boulez. It has also performed with singers including Thomas Quasthoff, Simon Keenlyside and Barbara Hannigan.

Lending his name to the Scharoun Ensemble is the architect of its musical home. In designing the Berlin Philharmonie, Hans Scharoun (1893-1972) created a concert hall that was unique in the world, undertaking a synthesis between innovation and awareness of tradition and opening up new approaches to artistic communication – ideals to which the Scharoun Ensemble is also committed.

Scharoun Ensemble Berlin



Over a two week period, the Scharoun Ensemble teaches young and talented musicians from all over the world. These extremely intensive workshops embrace all sorts of different types of chamber music. Students and members of the Scharoun Ensemble together make up the Zermatt Festival Orchestra. Furthermore, the Festival gives its participants the opportunity to work with internationally renowned soloists and composers. In 2014, there will be, among others, soprano Regula Mühlemann and violinist Kolja Balcher.

Both the Zermatt Festival and the Scharoun Ensemble Berlin attach great importance to supporting young musicians about to take their diploma exams, and who are therefore at the threshold of their career. In study programmes, priority is often given to instrumental classes as opposed to chamber music. The Academy, on the other hand, puts emphasis on working in small formations, without, however, neglecting lesser known works.

Teaching is dispensed by musicians who are members both of the Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra and the Scharoun Ensemble Berlin. Great experts of the chamber and orchestral repertoire, they offer these young musicians the highest level of coaching. The possibility of attending the Academy two years in a row allows particularly enriching teaching accompaniment.
